### Winemaking

Audaz Reserva was made from Aragonez, Trincadeira e Alicante Bouschet, which grapes were hand-picked. The fermentation process occurred in stainless steel tanks with temperature control, between 25°C-28°C.

### Tasting Notes

This wine flaunts an intense and attractive ruby colour. It reveals a fragrant aroma of ripe red fruit, enveloped by pleasurable toasted, smoked and spiced notes and is smooth and round, with generous well-embedded tannins on the palate. This wine is elegant in texture and culminates in a long and enduring finish.

### Serving suggestion

Enjoy with meat dishes and Portuguese tradition plates of codfish or just with a strong cheese. Serving temperature 16-18°C.
