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2019 Margan Rose & Bramble

Description

Our rose was made using a combination of varieties and winemaking styles. A blend of Merlot and Barbera picked and pressed off skins immediately to encourage floral aromatics and elegant fruits reminiscent of roses and bramble. A small parcel of skin fermented Pinot Gris provides a textural component to the finished wine. A reflection of the volcanic soils of Broke Fordwich using old vines and an eclectic approach to winemaking has produced a dry wine packed with mouthfeel and fresh fruit.

Tasting Notes Lifted berry aromas, amplified by delicate floral and perfume characters, textured, a hint of strawberry with a lingering dry finish

Winemakers Notes 2019 vintage was an outstanding Hunter Valley vintage characterized by warm days and cooler nights. The cooler nights preserved delicate aromatics and natural acidity. This wine was made using three different winemaking techniques. Merlot pick early and pressed immediately being treated like a white wine, Saignee of Barbera juice and cool fermented, plus skin fermented Pinot Gris. All three ferments were fermented to complete dryness and blended together to make a style with high natural acidity, mid palate texture and a crisp, dry finish.
